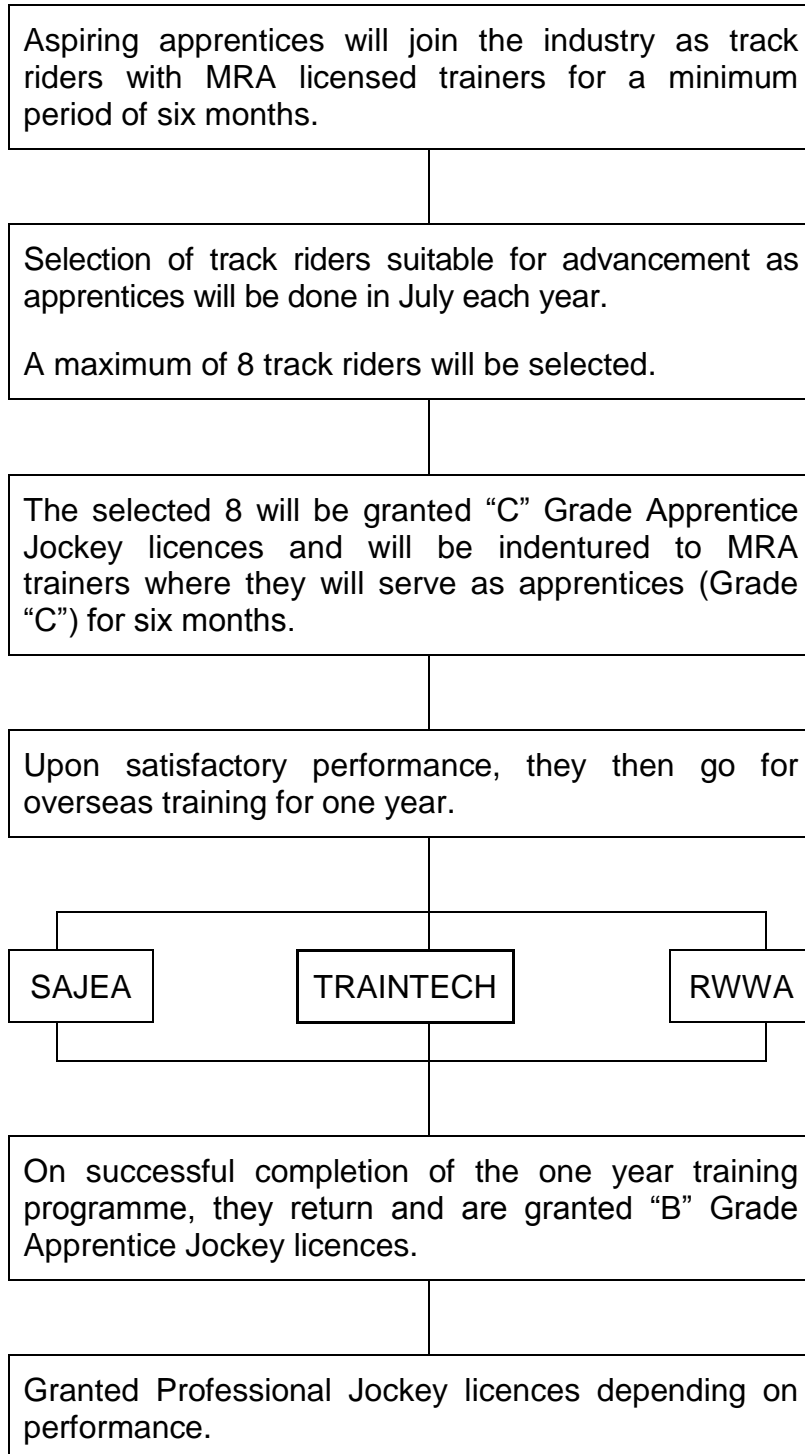

MRA REGULATIONS

25.11 Apprentice Jockey Training Scheme

- .1 The Malayan Racing Association's approved Apprentice Jockey Training Scheme is briefly outlined below:



Applicants, male or female, aspiring to be apprentice jockeys must satisfy the following conditions:-

- (i) be Singapore or Malaysian citizens;
 - (ii) be between the age of sixteen (16) years and twenty six (26) years;
 - (iii) be physically and mentally fit, with 6/6 vision and must pass a medical examination by a doctor approved by the Association;
 - (iv) riding weight must not exceed 50 kilogrammes at the time of the application for the licence;
 - (v) have completed at least primary education at PSLE or SRP level;
 - (vi) have passed a riding competency test conducted by the Stipendiary Stewards;
 - (vii) have passed a test on the MRA Rules of Racing;
 - (viii) have served at least six months as a track rider;
 - (ix) have parents' or guardians' consent if below the age of twenty one (21) years; and
 - (x) not have record of any criminal or bookmaking offences.
- .2 In July each year, the Panel of Stipendiary Stewards will interview all the applicants and select a maximum of eight track riders for the MRA Apprentice Training Scheme.
- .3 The selected candidates will be granted 'C' Grade Apprentice Jockey licences and be indentured to MRA licensed Trainers for a minimum period of five (5) years. During the indentureship, the apprentice will undergo local training for the first six (6) months before they are sent for their overseas attachment for a period of one (1) year.
- The Association will arrange for their attendance at the overseas training institutes for the apprentices and will provide them with economy return air passage and out-of-pocket allowance of S\$500 per month. Upon successful completion of the course, the apprentices will return to their trainers.
- .4 The apprentices' trainers/masters (local) will be responsible for their apprentices' board and lodging and are expected to continue paying the apprentices their usual salaries. Their local trainers will also take up an insurance policy for their apprentices while they are undergoing training overseas.
