PRESS STATEMENT

Deletions, Additions and Amendments to MRA Rules of Racing and Regulations

Annex A sets out the deletion, additions and amendments (highlighted in bold) to MRA Rules of Racing and Regulations for implementation.

MRA-Approved Spelling Stations for the 2013 Racing Season

2 Five spelling stations were approved as MRA-approved spelling stations for the 2013 racing season. The spelling stations are:

- .1 Genting Spelling Station
- .2 Hillsview Spelling Station
- .3 National Stud Farm
- .4 Ponderosa Spelling Resort
- .5 Racehorse Spelling Station Sdn Bhd

Registrations of Professional Trainer Licences

3 Applications for Professional Trainer licences by Shanmugam a/l subramaniam and Daniel James Murphy were officially registered with MRA.

4 They have six months (till 26 May 2013) to secure stabling facilities at any of the four associated Clubs, failing which their registrations will lapse.

Applications for "B" Grade Apprentice Jockey Licences

5 Lam Siew Leong, Mohd Aisisuhairi bin Kasim, Mohd Hamizan bin Hamzah, Mohamad Zulfikri bin Mohamad Salim and Yunes a/l Manimaran were granted "B" Grade Apprentice Jockey licences for the remainder of the 2012 and 2013 racing seasons. Lam Siew Leong would be indentured to Trainer Dr Tan Swee Hock, Mohd Aisisuhairi bin Kasim would be indentured to Trainer Steven Harold Burridge, Mohd Hamizan bin Hamzah, Mohamad Zulfikri bin Mohamad Salim and Yunes a/l Manimaran would be indentured to Trainer Richard Victor Lines.

6 Yang Chee Leong was granted a "B" Grade Apprentice Jockey licence for the period from 1 December 2012 to 30 May 2013, both dates inclusive. He would be indentured to Trainer Loh Kin Kuen.

Applications for "C" Grade Apprentice Jockey Licences

**DELETION, ADDITIONS AND AMENDMENTS
TO MRA RULES OF RACING AND REGULATIONS**

MRA RULES OF RACING

PART I : PRELIMINARY

Interpretation

Rule 6(1) [*Amended rule to be effective from 1 December 2012*]

“Bleeders Test” means a test in which a horse gallops over a distance of at least a 1000 metres in the presence of a Stipendiary Steward, followed by a clinical examination of the horse by a veterinary surgeon that will include trotting up, auscultation of the heart and lungs and an endoscopic examination of the upper and lower respiratory tracts.

“Immediate Family” means:

- (a) a spouse;
- (b) a child (including an adopted child, a step-child, a daughter-in-law or a son-in-law);
- (c) a father or mother (including a father-in-law or mother-in-law); and
- (d) a brother or sister (including a half-brother, a half-sister, an adopted brother, an adopted sister, a step-brother, a step-sister, **a brother-in-law or a sister-in-law**).

PART IV : TRAINERS

Employment of an Assistant Trainer or Stable Supervisor

Rule 38 [*Deleted rule to be effective from 1 December 2012*]

- (1) A Trainer may employ an Assistant Trainer for every twenty (20) horses under his charge, or such other number of horses as shall be determined and notified from time to time by the Association.

- (2) An Assistant Trainer may, with the written permission of the Local Committee, deputise for his Trainer at race meetings where such Trainer has been granted permission to be absent or is otherwise unable to attend such race meetings.
- (3) A Trainer may employ one Stable Supervisor for every ten (10) horses under his charge up to a maximum of four (4) Stable Supervisors, or such other numbers as shall be determined and notified from time to time by the Association.

PART VI: RIDERS

Race Riding and further responsibilities of jockeys

Rule 44A [Amended rule to be effective from 1 January 2013]

- (4) For the purposes of this Rule which may be applied retrospectively:
 - (a) **a jockey** who has ridden winners in a **foreign country, which is recognised by the Association**, shall have the number of winners calculated in accordance with that country's Rules of Racing relevant to jockey allowances. Upon his return and before he rides in a race, the jockey must submit to the Secretary of the Association a written notification issued by a recognised Racing Authority in that **country** stating the number of winners he has **ridden**; and
 - (b) **an apprentice** who has ridden winners in a **foreign country, which is recognised by the Association**, shall have the number of winners **in a group/listed/ premier/metropolitan race in that country calculated relevant to the apprentice allowances**. Upon his return and before he rides in a race, the apprentice must submit to the Secretary of the Association a written notification issued by a recognised Racing Authority in that **country** stating the number of winners **in a group/listed/premier/ metropolitan race** he has **ridden**.

PART VIII : OWNERSHIP OF HORSES

Horses which Bleed

Rule 92 [Amended rule to be effective from 1 December 2012]

- (1) Bleeding is defined as the appearance of blood of pulmonary origin at either or both nostrils, irrespective of the quantity, after exercise.
- (2) If a horse bleeds during a race or during track work, the Trainer shall immediately report the fact to a Veterinary Surgeon and/or a Stipendiary Stewards who shall inform the Secretary of the Association.
- (3) A horse that has been declared to be a Bleeder hereunder shall not, without the written permission of the Stipendiary Stewards:
 - (a) Be cantered or galloped on the main training tracks of any racecourse for a period of two (2) months after such declaration.
 - (b) **Be entered for a bleeders test for a period of three (3) months after such declaration.**
 - (c) **Start in any race for a period of three (3) months after such declaration, and then only after passing the bleeders test.**
- (4) A horse that races three times without bleeding after serving the initial three-month ban shall be considered to have reverted to non-bleeder status.
- (5) A horse that suffers a second bleeding attack during training or racing and has not just prior to such bleeding attack raced three times without bleeding shall not, without the written permission of the Stipendiary Stewards:
 - (a) Be cantered or galloped on the main training tracks of any racecourse for a period of five (5) months after such second bleeding attack.
 - (b) **Be entered for a bleeders test for a period of six (6) months after such declaration.**
 - (c) **Start in any race for a period of six (6) months, and then only after passing the bleeders test.**
- (6) A horse that races three times without bleeding after having served the six (6) month ban shall revert to non-bleeder status.

- (7) A horse that suffers a third bleeding attack during training or racing without having reverted to non-bleeder status as defined in Rule 92(4) or 92(6) shall be permanently banned from racing.
- (8) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, the Stewards on receiving a written report from the Veterinary Surgeon, endorsed by the Stipendiary Stewards, shall have the right to refuse entries permanently or for any recommended length of time for any horse that they may consider to be a serious risk to racing at any stage.

PART IX : RACE MEETINGS

The Running and Conduct of Races

Rule 117 [Amended rule to be effective from 1 December 2012]

- (1) All races shall be run, and every horse shall be raced and ridden on merit and as are prescribed by these Rules.
- (2) The Local Committee or the Stewards may inquire into any matter or any incident in any race and may take appropriate action in terms of their powers under these Rules at any time they may deem it necessary.
- (3) Notwithstanding the above, the Stipendiary Stewards may inquire into the performance of any horse in a race and should the performance of any horse be found to be inconsistent or unreliable it may be suspended from racing or training and in addition the Trainer may be held liable for any such performance where such inconsistency or unreliability is caused by or contributed to by the riding instructions of the Trainer, or the lack of such instructions.
- (4) An Owner is not permitted to give instructions directly to his jockey but must do so through the Trainer of his horse.
- (5) **If in the opinion of the Stewards, a jockey remains in contact with the horse or any part of his gear from the start to the finish of a race, his horse is deemed to have carried the weight at which the jockey has weighed out subject to MRA Rule of Racing 121(2) and shall be declared a starter of the race.**

MRA REGULATIONS

HORSES

Official Race Trials

Regulation 9.2 *[Amended regulation to be effective from 1 December 2012]*

All unraced horses will be required to pass an Official Race Trial before they can be **declared** to race. The results of the Official Race Trial will be valid for a period of two months preceding the date of entry for the race meeting.

Starting Stall Tests and Procedures

Regulation 15.5 *[Amended regulation to be effective from 1 December 2012]*

A horse will not be eligible to be **declared** for a race until it has passed the required test conducted by an Official whose decision shall be final.

PERSONS : LICENSED OR REGISTERED

Stable Supervisors

Regulation 30.1 *[Amended regulation to be effective from 1 December 2012]*

As a guide, a Trainer **may** employ a Stable Supervisor for every ten (10) horses under his charge or such other numbers as shall be determined and notified from time to time by the Association.

Assistant Trainers

Regulation 33 *[Amended regulation to be effective from 1 December 2012]*

- .1 **As a guide**, a Trainer **may** employ an Assistant Trainer for every twenty (20) horses under his charge or such other numbers as shall be determined and notified from time to time by the Association.
- .2 **An Assistant Trainer should be available to attend race meetings and deputise for a Trainer who has been granted permission to be absent or is unable to attend race meetings.**

.3 Assistant Trainer Licensing Criteria

An applicant for an Assistant Trainer licence must be from one of the following three categories:

- .1 A person who holds or has held an Assistant Trainer licence or its equivalent for a period of at least one (1) year with a registered racing authority; or**
- .2 A person who has successfully completed the Diploma of Horse Business Management Course conducted by the Marcus Oldham College or Certificate IV in Racing (Thoroughbred) – Trainer course conducted by Traintech 2000 Pty Ltd or such other institutions approved by the Association; or**
- .3 A citizen or permanent resident of Malaysia or Singapore who satisfies the following criteria :**
 - .1 he is a stablehand who has served at least three years as a Stable Supervisor at its equivalent grade with a licensed trainer with a recognised racing authority; or**
 - .2 he is a veterinary surgeon or jockey who has served up to a year as a Stable Supervisor. In exceptional cases, they can be directly appointed as an Assistant Trainer;**
 - .3 a jockey who has completed a one-year course on stable management with a recognised overseas racing institution, such as the Taft College in Australia or the University of Arizona in the United States; or**
 - .4 he is a former official of the Association.**

All applicants for an Assistant Trainer licence:

- .1 Must have a good disciplinary record;**
- .2 Must have passed a practical and theoretical examination set by the Stipendiary Stewards;**
- .3 Must be recommended by the Stipendiary Stewards;**
- .4 Must pass a medical examination conducted by a MRA-approved doctor;**

- .5 Preferably have a secondary education or its equivalent;
and**
- .6 Must not have record of any criminal or book-making
offences.**
